



## New Mexico State Hi Power Championships



July 16, 17, 18, 2010

CAPITAN, NEW MEXICO

The New Mexico State High Power Championships were held at the Capitan Hi Power Shooting Club range, 3 miles east of Capitan on July 16, 17, 18, 2010. Except for Friday afternoon when the team match got weathered out, the weather was very nice. Winds stayed under 10mph but were somewhat tricky. Temperatures were warm on Saturday and Sunday, but not anything like they were experiencing off of the mountain.

We had 12 shooters for the 600 yard matches on Friday morning. Bill Rodolph from Alto was holding hard in the first match of the day with a new range record of 200-13X. This was an any sight match. Bill continued his winning ways by holding off Paul Myers from Alamogordo in the iron sight match shooting a 195-6X to Myers' 194-6X. Bill took the aggregate of the two matches with a 395-19X. Paul Myers won the combined master and expert class with a 390-11X. Dick Holland from Midland, Tx won the combined sharpshooter and marksman class with a 357-12X.

On Saturday morning we started the state championship. The first match of the day is the offhand match shot at 200 yards. Shooters shot 20 shots for record from the standing position, slow fire. Winner of the offhand match was Paul Kerr from Albuquerque, NM with a 194-0X. The next match to be contested is the sitting rapid fire match, also shot at 200 yards. Shooters shoot two, 10 shot strings, each string having a time limit of 60 seconds with a reload. Ron Zerr from El Paso, Tx was match winner with a 200-17X! Wow, what an X count!

The third match of the day is the 300 yard rapid fire prone match. Contestants fire two, 10 shot strings, each string has a time limit of 70 seconds and you must reload. Ron Zerr won a tie breaker over Bill Rodolph and was declared match winner with a 198-8. The tie breaker in this instance was who shot the best score on the last string. Ron shot a 99-4X to Rodolph's 98-4X to win the tie breaker.

The last match of the day is shot at 600 yards, slow fire, prone. 2 sighters and 20 shots for record ends the day. Ron Zerr was again match winner with a 199-7X. Ron did a fine job of mastering the tricky winds.

Our new state champion and of course match winner was Ron Zerr. Ron's aggregate score was 789-33X. Good shooting Ron! Service rifle champion and high state resident was Paul Kerr with a 776-20. Winner of the master class was Tim Pacheco from Ignacio, Co with a 767-17X. The expert class was won by Ramon Grado from El Paso, Tx with a 749-18X. The top sharpshooter on the day was Dick Holland with a 716-14X and top marksman was Daniel Castello from Socorro, NM with a 694-5X.

Special awards went to Daniel Castello, high junior; and Raymond Diaz from Austin, Tx was high senior.

Sunday is "leg match" day. Service rifle shooters are fighting for points toward their Distinguished Marksman badge issued by the Civilian Marksmanship Program, CMP. The weather was great with it being pretty calm until the 600 yard line. Shooters shoot a 50 shot, no sighter match with 10 shots offhand, 10 shots sitting rapid fire, 10 shots prone rapid fire and ending with 20 shots slow prone at the 600 yard line. Paul Kerr was match winner with a 471-9X. Since Paul is already distinguished the 6 point leg and silver medal went to David Crider from Roswell, NM with a 466-9X. The bronze medal went to Tim Pacheco with a 466-7X. Those two were really battling it out for the 6 point leg! Just goes to show that X's can make a difference.

Other than the weather stopping the team match, the weekend went off without a hitch. Special thanks go to Larry Kimpell for being our very capable line officer and Jerry King for running the pits. Sha Lene Dobbs and Tammy Myers were our stat office and Paul Myers produced the bulletin. Without these people and their help we could never run this match.
